I wanted to share a promotion currently being offered by the NRA. Prices are good for a limited time and I will only know that they end when I get an email from the NRA.

If you renew annually like I do, to give the club a \$6 bonus for Jr Trap, now is the time. 1-year membership prices are \$30 (discounted \$5 from the current club member price but \$15 off the \$45 normal NRA yearly membership.

3 year memberships are not discounted beyond what they already are for club members at \$85 but if you want to buy a 5 year membership or renewal, the prices is discounted to \$100 (\$25 savings off our normal price of \$125 for club members.) #### DEFENSIVE PISTOL COURSE

Master Sergeants at Arms, LLC is offering a NON-NRA Defensive Pistol Course on Saturday, 6 June 2020 (76th anniversary of D-Day) at COSC. Course is geared towards current CPL holders seeking to enhance marksmanship skill sets. Instructor is NRA certified as well as former US Army Special Forces with 35 years' experience.

Show up time is 08:15 with five hours of training ending at 14:00/2PM (no lunch.) Maximum class size is eight.

Training schedule: Admin/Safety brief, dynamic shooting drills including: fundamentals refresher, movements to neutralize threats, barricades-low and high, range from contact to 25 yd. engagement, 21 foot moving target, other events time permitting.

Cost: \$125.00 for COSC family members or US Veterans, \$150.00 all others.

What to bring: clothing appropriate for the weather, long work pants (we will be outdoors, training will go on rain or shine except if lightning is present,) your carry firearm if you'd like to bring additional pistol/revolver to try out, that's okay,) 300-325 training rounds, a quality holster/belt rig (recommend a strong side hip holster made particularly for your handgun,) 3-4 magazines/speed loaders with belt pouch for same, eye/ear protection, water, coffee, snacks, sun screen, bug juice as you need. # **Archery Update:**

Our 3D range is now set up and is OPEN for members only. Our Saturday Open House from 9 AM - 2 PM is on hold until Governor Whitmer cancels the "Stay Home" order. New to our 3D range this year is a 3D pro Elk and a 3D pro Wolverine.



Last year we were presented with "The Best of 2019 Dimondale Archery Club." We are hoping to continue with a great archery season again this year.

A big THANKS to all who showed up to open the range with their quad runners and willingness to work. Setting the range up takes a lot of work. With the 3D range open, so are a lot of work opportunities. Here are some ideas of what you might do for a club discount:

- 1. The antlers need to be sorted and set out on the right 3D animals. The antlers are in the archery shed in a large white plastic bag across from the work bench.
- 2. UV water protector needs to be sprayed on all targets, both range and raised platforms. UV water protector and the sprayer are in the archery shed on the work bench. Please clean out sprayer when done using.
- 3. Ant poison needs to be applied around all targets. The ant poison is in the archery shed in a factory shaker zip lock bag, on the shelf above the work bench. Light dusting around the base of the target.
- 4. Herbicide needs to be applied around the base of the bow tacks. The herbicide and the backpack sprayer are in the archery shed on the back of the work bench. Herbicide needs to be mixed with water. Best applied if the wind is not blowing. Spray around the base of the bow racks on the 3D range. Please rinse out after use.
- 5. Mowing the 3D range needs to be kept up. Every 2 weeks, or every week when the grass is growing fast. The red mower is in the archery shed. Gas, oil, and grease, if needed, are in the mowing shed.
- 6. Trim back brush growing into the main trail. There are 2 sets of loppers hanging on the left wall in the archery shed. Please put back when done.
- 7. The raised platform at 10 & 11 will not be tore down. We will put new bracing underneath the lower deck.
- 8. Check for large holes in the 3D targets made by birds or mice. Fill with expanding foam, found on the shelf above the work bench in the archery shed.
- 9. Paint an older 3D target. There is pain in the store room under the club house in gallon pails of white, black, tan, gray, and brown.

You'll need a "B" key to get into the archery shed and store room. Please call one of us on the archery committee.
