The weather is cooperating. We have some great weather for being outdoors!

The warm (Okay, HOT) weather has meant we have more people out shooting early in the day and late in the day.

Early shooters, please remember that you are welcome to come out early and set up targets and lay out gear, but no shooting before 9am.

Late shooters, please remember that all shooting must stop one half hour before sunset. I just typed in "Lansing sunset" in Google. The first hit, right at the top of the list says "9:02pm." So, no noise after 8:32pm.

While I am sure some of the noise complaints are actually other neighbors shooting on their own property, I am equally sure that some of the complaints are members shooting after quitting time. This jeopardizes the existence of our range. Michigan law prohibits local jurisdictions from passing firearms laws more restrictive than the state law. However, there is no such limit on them passing noise ordinances that would limit our opportunity to shoot.

This is a serious enough issue that, at the last meeting, the board voted to make the penalty for the first offense be removing a person's membership. Please do not test that limit.

COWBOY ACTION

Once again, it's time to COWBOY UP! 2025 Cowboy Action shooting at COSC started April 12th. Shoots will be held on the second and fourth Saturdays of each month April through October. Cowboy Action shooting is open to the public as well as club members though there is a \$5 charge for each contestant. It consists of shooting with lever action rifles, single action handguns and either side by side double barrel shotguns (without ejectors) or Winchester model 1897 pump action shotguns. We will mainly be shooting at steel targets though we may occasionally shoot paper targets. Centerfire and rimfire rifles and pistols are acceptable. If you are short on having the proper equipment to start with, some members will be glad to loan you the proper equipment during the shoot. Setup time is from 830am – 9am. Shooting starts at 9am and is usually finished between 11am and noon. Remaining shooting dates for 2025 are 8-9 and 8-23, 9-13 and 9-27, 10-11 and 10-25.
